#### Some things to note:

Use the hashtags that have been nominated for use during this disaster. Hashtags are searchable bookmarks that allow people to search for relevant content using the tags. They can also increase the number of people who will see the messages.

Using images in posts attract attention. Adding an image to each post is encouraged. Please note that different social media platforms use different sized images. Correct sizes can be found by searching "social media post sizes".

NO REQUIREMENT	Additionally, many volunteer organisations working in disaster recovery have not yet been asked for help but are remaining alert. This situation may change as requests for assistance arise.  While all offers to volunteer are appreciated, we need to ensure the right help is given at the right time, in the right place. The best action you can take at this time is to stop, listen to and follow the directions of trusted sources including state and local government authorities and recognised volunteer-involving organisations working in disaster recovery. They will let you know what the best course of action is.  Volunteering is a very good way to help in times of need, but it is important to be mindful that the needs and readiness of impacted people and communities always come first. Turning up in disaster impacted areas is not in anyone's interest, can be unsafe, and be a drain on critical resources and infrastructure. Currently it is still not possible to access some [event] affected areas due to high health and safety risks.
